Earn Loan Forgiveness with Family Medicine!

The new Forgivable Education Loans for Service Program offers up to \$25,000 per year to medical students committed to primary care in underserved rural areas.

As part of the budget established by the NC General Assembly in 2023, qualified students who are enrolled in an approved education program and committed to working in critical employment shortage professions in North Carolina are eligible to receive this financial assistance.

Program Details

- The program pays \$25,000 per year of medical school
- Open to primary care specialties or psychiatry
- Requires one year of service per year of funding
- Eligible service areas include Tier 1 and Tier 2 counties - 80 out of 100 counties in NC!

NC medical students currently in their first, second, or third years are eligible to apply for the 2024-2025 academic year now. The application window closes March 1st.

The NCAFP has long advocated for direct financial support for medical students. We are grateful for the General Assembly's \$16 million investment in primary care through this program, and for future family physicians receiving much deserved support to care directly for our state's underserved communities.
